



HOSPITALS USE BERNER to: Protect Indoor Air Comfort





MAIN ENTRANCES:

Both ambient and heated Berner air curtains are used on high-traffic main entrances, along with or instead of a vestibule, to protect the Welcome & Waiting areas from outside temperatures and traffic fumes as patients, families and staff come & go.

Revolving Doors -

Often by-passed in favor of the swing door next to it, hospitals use air curtains to protect these entrances from outside temperatures.



ER (EMERGENCY ROOM) ENTRANCE:

Keep vehicle exhaust out and the triage and registration areas comfortable as doors open to allow First Responders and their patients in.

SERVICE DOOR: Facilities Manager

Facilities Managers use Berner air curtains over man doors to protect back hallways from outside temperatures, secondhand smoke, truck exhaust and flying insects.

LOADING DOCKS:

Health systems use Berner air curtains as a simple and energy-efficient way to keep indoor temperatures stable, flying insects out and the interior fume-free when unloading supplies or taking out the recycling.

KITCHEN / CAFETERIA DOORS:


Often outsourced to Food Service Consultants, air curtains are used for chemical-free insect control on kitchen doors and to contain smells on hallway doors.












